This project is to design and launch an enhanced program to share knowledge and provide operational practices of handling high value goods logistics services to Hong Kong SMEs in order to enhance their knowledge level and logistics capabilities. A series of seminars and workshops were designed and organized to provide an integration of emerging topics of high value goods logistics in different industries as well as interactive and hands-on activities. Booklets including project information and proposed topics in Chinese and videos of highlights of seminars and workshops were developed and posted on the project website. It is expected that SMEs in Hong Kong can benefit from this enhanced program so as to strengthen their capabilities in handling high value goods logistics services.
