### Project Summary (in about 150 words)

Having regard AGF comments and views from others, the 2016-2017 Budget also mentioned that the Financial Secretary will set-up a Resource Centre to provide technical training and support for young design SMEs, and this Sample Development Centre will be part of the Resource Centre.

This Centre not only provides prototype sampling service to Hong Kong fashion design SMEs, but also offers studio space, machinery, equipment and facilities, as extension to support the young design SMEs to create their own collection. CITA will work closely with AGF and the Hong Kong Design Centre (Secretariat to AGF) pertinent to overall industry development direction and design promotion, and will foster exchange and better overall advisory, collaboration, communication and co-ordination with relevant stakeholders such as incubation centres, designer and industry associations, education establishments, etc

## Project Objective(s) (in about 80 words)

Hong Kong fashion designers who run their own brands as SME have great talents but faced with unsolved problems to develop their creative designs into the first garment sample for commercialization. This centre aims to provide an effective design-to-production communication system and service to transform the fashion designers' ideas into a prototype within the allowed budget of materials, labour and overhead.
