1. Project Details

Project summary (in about 150 words)

The project consists of six seminars and one conference focusing on Cambodia, Indonesia and Myanmar. It aims to provide Hong Kong construction industry with up-to-date information on business environment for making insightful and discreet business expansion and collaboration in these countries.

This project attracted about 520 attendees to attend the six seminars and over 150 attendees to attend the conference. A project website was available for the participants and the public to access to the information including presentation materials and video clips of the seminars and conference.

Project objectives (in about 50 words)

The project aims to provide up-to-date information on the trends of the development of Cambodia, Indonesia and Myanmar on business environment in relation to infrastructure and building sectors. It intends to give an in-depth discussion on relevant regulation and policies in the regions, to analyse the factors that might influence the opportunities, risk management and business strategies of the construction industry in their infrastructure and building projects in Cambodia, Indonesia and Myanmar.

- (v) The date of the 6th seminar was postponed to 20 May 2022 due to difficulties in recruiting speakers from Myanmar. Thus, the production of the event pamphlet and eDM as well as the uploading of the video clips were also delayed.
- (vi) The target completion dates were extended to 30/04/2022 and 09/08/2022 respectively after a project amendment approved on 27 Jan 2022.
