## 1. Project Details

#### Project summary (in about 150 words)

The significance of Hong Kong as the prominent aviation hub in Asia is facing challenges from other neighbouring hubs, such as Singapore, Beijing, Shenzhen, Guangzhou, etc. The opening of new airports and the expansion of existing airports in these areas will draw passenger traffic and cargo traffic to their region. All related enterprises in the aviation industry in Hong Kong will definitely be affected. However, Hong Kong is still playing an important role in national development plan. The Chinese Government is fully behind Hong Kong taking a leading role as an air hub to help advance China's ambitious global trade and infrastructure strategy.

To catch up with the development opportunities, Hong Kong has to uphold its existing advantages in quality, reliability and safety compliance in the comprehensive chains of product and service provisions. Moreover, we need to move a step forward to further strengthen our status as "International Aviation Hub" by demonstrating our efforts in technology and service innovation.
