### 1. Project Details

#### Project summary (in about 150 words)

The project was to set up two Hong Kong Smart City Pavilions, in China Hi-Tech Fair (CHTF) in Shenzhen on 27-29 Dec 2021 and China Smart City Expo (CSCE) in Beijing in September 2022 respectively, to reinforce Hong Kong's position as a leading smart city in the region. Collaborating organisations of the project are Hong Kong Software Industry Association, and Hong Kong Information Technology Joint Council.

HK Smart City pavilion in China Smart City Expo 2022 in Beijing, originally scheduled in August/September 2022, was cancelled due to ongoing pandemic. The cancellation notice is announced by expo organiser in September 2022.

The products and services of 25 Hong Kong companies in IoT, Information Security and Property and Property Technology sectors were presented at HK Smart City Pavilion at CHTF 2021. Publicity efforts included project website, press releases, exhibition booklets and TV wall introducing the performance of Hong Kong ICT sectors. The Pavilion was also awarded "Excellent Design" award. According to the questionnaire of Pavilion at CHTF, 80% exhibitors (out of 25 exhibitors) believed the Pavilion helped promote HK's IT image, 76% believed it helped boost the industry competitiveness and attract mainland/foreign users' attention; while 68% agreed it helped build business network. All exhibitors in the HK Pavilion indicated they would participate again if there were opportunities in future.

The HK Smart City Pavilion are sponsored by the Trade and Industrial Organisation Support Fund from the Trade and Industry Department, HKSAR Government.

#### Project objectives (in about 50 words)

With the rapid development of internet, ICT have become omnipresent in our daily lives. Many mainland cities are finding efficient ICT solutions to improve urban management. The proposed project aims to provide a platform at major exhibitions for HK's ICT sectors to establish business relationship with potential partners and return with innovative solutions and ideas, hence enhancement of HK's technology development.

Developing into Smart Cities is the present trend of advanced counties in the world. As a cosmopolitan city, Hong Kong strives to be a leader in this field through the consolidation of new technologies such as the Internet of Things (IoT), information security, and property technology, etc. The urban problems in Hong Kong, such as the land scarcity, pollution, and more, have brought valuable business opportunities and industrial development to Smart City enterprises, in order to find efficient solutions. The project is a combination of the online and offline promotion, to promote the business of Hong Kong's Smart City related IT businesses through the establishment of the Hong Kong Pavilion, business matching, and social applications.
